The goal of this meeting is to review and recommend the draft implementation tables to the Policy Committee. At the meeting, we will break into small groups to gather your feedback on the actions for each planning region. For your review prior to the meeting, we are asking the Advisory Committee to focus on the following:

1. The actions themselves; did we miss anything?
2. Level of effort which explains where the funding will come. WBIF =Watershed Based Implementation Funds, Baseline = existing funding, and Other = grants or other sources. Remember, not all actions are eligible for WBIF, but they can be still listed in the plan if that will help partners leverage funding.
3. Targeted Resources shows where the activities will take place within the planning area or watershed.
4. Lead/Supporting Entities is who will champion the project to completion.

Other parts of the table (timeline, costs) will be completed by the Steering Committee.
